

**PORT OF GARIBALDI
RESOLUTION NO. 2024-01**

A RESOLUTION SETTING RATES, FEES, AND CHARGES

WHEREAS, Part III of Ordinance No. 15 states that rates, fees, and charges shall be set by resolution of the Port of Garibaldi Commission; and

WHEREAS, ORS 294.160 requires the governing body of a unit of local government to provide an opportunity for interested persons to comment on the enactment of any ordinance or resolution prescribing a new fee or a fee increase; and

WHEREAS, Port of Garibaldi Rates and Fees Schedule was last adopted on December 14, 2022 by Resolution No. 2023-01; and

WHEREAS, the resolution set forth below will be in effect as of the date January 1, 2024 and all rates and fees as adjusted will be enacted as such; and

WHEREAS, the Port Commission feels that user fees should help to offset those costs related to the depreciation and on-going maintenance of the port; NOW THEREFORE,

THE PORT OF GARIBALDI BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Permanent Moorage. Due annually on August 1st. Port reserves the right to place an additional surcharge on utilities upon utility rate increases. Vessels over 40-ft. add \$6.00/ft. over 40-ft.

C. Market Style Events (Garibaldi Days/Seafood & Spirits Festival).

All vendors must fill out and submit vendor application with payment in advance of the market. Any food vendor must adhere to all City, County and State health code requirements in advance of the market.

Section 13. Delegation of Responsibility. The Commission delegates to Manager the ability to adjust these rates on a temporary basis to better manage services at the Port of Garibaldi. Any adjustments to these rates will be reported to the Commission at its next regular meeting.

Section 14. Annual Review. The Commission, through assistance by Port staff, shall annually review and adopt a new rate, fees and charges resolution prior to the subsequent budget's adoption.


Section 15. Repeal. All previous rates and/or rate resolutions are hereby repealed.
